Ecumenical Youth Fellowship—Fun & fellowship await all junior and senior high age students when they meet with their adult sponsors for weekly meals and meetings. Recreational activities, camps and other outings provide the backdrop of our youth’s spiritual needs. We are joined in this program by other Christian denominations, such as the Episcopal and First Christian Churches of Kingsville.

More Opportunities!

United Methodist Women—Six circles of the UMW Organization are currently active and serving our church with their exciting work in areas of special emphasis, including Community, Social and Global concerns.

Better Years—One of the liveliest groups in the church! These folks, age 55 and older, gather weekly for an informative program, a light meal together, and life-giving fellowship.

Chancel Choir & Handbells—If you enjoy making music with other joyful Christians, then either of these groups is for you. You don’t need to read music or be a trained musician. Your willingness to share your faith in song is sufficient qualification!

Disciple Bible Study—A Bible study for those who are willing to risk being transformed by the Word. No previous knowledge of the Bible is necessary. In the first year’s course, we will cover the entire Bible in 34 weeks; the second year is devoted to in-depth study of Genesis/Exodus and Luke/Acts. A minimum of eight persons is necessary for a class. The workbook is \$30.

Academy of Discipleship—A 10 week course divided into 3 “steps” of 3-4 sessions each. This is designed for those who wish to grow in their discipleship to Jesus and to share their faith with others. It is designed both for those with little background in the church, and those who have been Christians a long time. The workbook is \$5.
